COURSE ASSESSMENT

Candidates will complete the assessment in three sections:

Section 1 – Theory: This consists of 20 Short Answer Questions (45 minutes allowed) 30%

Section 2 – CPR Students will demonstrate proficiency in the application of CPR and use of an AED – 40%

Section 3 – Other First Aid Skills includes practical skills from the 8 core modules 30%

All assessment is carried out in accordance with FETAC (NCVA) regulations. The Assessment is devised by the internal assessor, with external moderation by FETAC.
